Richard Emerson, Known as the Godfather of Craft brewing in New Zealand. Starting up his own brewery in Dunedin in 1992 Every cent was precious so he borrowed, begged or repurposed wherever he could. His first brew - London Porter, was ready for market 1993, to this day it is stil Emersons flagship dark beer.

TASTING NOTES

One of New Zealand's first new generation pale ales and now a classic, Emerson's 1812 is in our humble opinion a masterpiece of balance. Pouring a bright amber hue beneath a deep cream coloured head, the aroma hints at caramel offset by a light fruitiness. Medium bodied, the palate first offers a marmaladey combination of ripe citrus and caramelised malts before the resiny hops bring home a lingering dry finish.
