


Pilsner 4.9%



Richard Emerson, Known as the Godfather of Craft brewing in New Zealand. Starting up his own brewery in Dunedin in 1992 Every cent was precious so he borrowed, begged or repurposed wherever he could. His first brew - London Porter, was ready for market 1993, to this day it is stil Emersons flagship dark beer.

Tasting notes

A Kiwi classic, Emerson's Pilsner beautifully showcases Nelson grown Riwaka hops. It's overt fruitiness oozes citrus and passionfruit aromas and flavours, and begs comparison with Marlborough's world-beating Sauvignon Blancs. The beer's palate shows a hint of early malt sweetness but develops a lengthy dry finish. So not a bad drop then.
