Superbly aromatic and textured wine. One of the few examples in NZ made from Syrah. Barrel fermented with natural yeasts and aged on lees, this dry wine is beautifully balanced and food friendly.

"The delicious 2014 vintage was made from Syrah, estate grown in Waipara and fermented with indigenous yeasts in tanks. An inviting, bright, pale pink wine, it is attractively scented, mouthfilling and vibrantly fruity, with strawberry, spice and watermelon flavours, showing excellent depth and freshness, and basically a dry (4g/L of residual sugar) finish. "Light purple-pink colour with some depth, lighter on rim. The nose is fresh and pretty with fruit aromas of strawberries and raspberries and cream, lifted by subtle confectionary notes. A minerally steeliness lends depth and intensity. Dry to taste, bright and vibrantly sweet fruit flavours of raspberries and cream are lifted by strawberry and red floral notes. The mouthfeel features a fine textural line with balanced background acidity, is dry and mouthwatering. Delicate confectionary nuances add attractive detail, and the flavours carry through to a crisp, dry, fine and lingering finish. This is a crisp, dry and vibrant rosé with delicate raspberry and cream fruit flavours"
