



GEORGES ROAD NOBLE RIESLING 2013

A superbly balanced Riesling, made from fully botrytised grapes. Picked over two passes through the vineyard, pressed once and fermented with natural yeasts.

CRITICAL COMMENT

'Georges Road Noble Riesling 2013 ★★★★★ **17.5+/20**

Bright straw-yellow colour with depth, lighter on rim. This has a tightly concentrated nose with a soft melange of aromas with yellow florals, lime, marmalade and honey, with musky botrytis and a delicate lift. Medium-sweet to sweet in taste and with good body, the palate has a firm and driven core of flavours showing exotic florals and citrus fruits, entwined with herbs and musk, the botrytis quite restrained. The mouthfeel is lively with balanced acidity and a fine grainy line underscores the palate flow, the textures suggesting unctuousness. The acidity and extract carry the palate to a long, sustained finish with wild honey, herb and musk flavours.'
